

GO ONLINE FOR CARBON COUNTER

A new online service which will help prepare businesses for the CRC Energy Efficiency Scheme has been launched by environmental data specialists, [Landmark Information Group](#).

The new service, developed in partnership with UK consultancy EnviroS, has been designed specifically to help organisations in the public and private sector comply with all the requirements of the CRC.

Carbon Counter will help organisations to establish whether they are legally obliged to register for CRC. If so, it will then enable them to map energy consumption across each individual component of their business

structure using clear on-screen guidance.

David Mole, of Landmark Environment, said: "This service comes at a crucial time as registration for the CRC scheme starts in April and it is estimated that up to 20,000 UK businesses could be affected, with 5,000 having to be registered for the scheme.

"It is widely regarded that awareness of the scheme is low, with a recent survey from SAP revealing that a fifth of companies have not even started planning or have no idea what measures they need to take."
